<b>What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a>?</b>	<a href="#">Preferred provider</a> : \$0 / individual or \$0 / family per calendar year. <a href="#">Nonpreferred provider</a> : \$1,000 / individual or \$3,000 / family per calendar year	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <a href="#">providers</a> up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this <a href="#">plan</a> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a> , each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a> .
<b>Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a>?</b>	Yes. Services by a <a href="#">preferred provider</a> are covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a>	This <a href="#">plan</a> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount. But a <a href="#">copayment</a> or <a href="#">coinsurance</a> may apply. For example, this <a href="#">plan</a> covers certain <a href="#">preventive services</a> without <a href="#">cost sharing</a> and before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> . <b>What is the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> for this <a href="#">plan</a>?</b>	<a href="#">Preferred provider</a> & <a href="#">Nonpreferred provider</a> combined <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> . <b>What is not included in the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a>?</b>	Penalties for failure to obtain <a href="#">preauthorization</a> for services, <a href="#">premiums</a> , <a href="#">balance-billing</a> charges, and health care this <a href="#">plan</a> doesn't cover. This <a href="#">plan</a> uses a <a href="#">provider network</a> . You will pay less if you use a <a href="#">provider</a> in the <a href="#">plan's network</a> . You will pay the most if you use an <a href="#">out-of-network provider</a> , and you might receive a bill from a <a href="#">provider</a> for the difference between the <a href="#">provider's</a> charge and what your <a href="#">plan</a> pays ( <a href="#">balance billing</a> ). **Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.**
